Neighbors find understanding, connection, kind words & compassion.

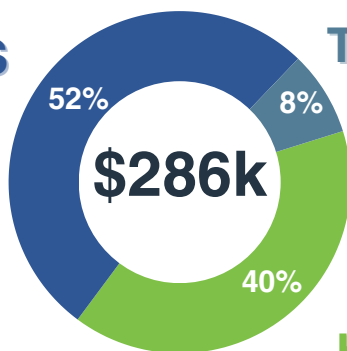
1,554 families received **\$286,000** (an average of \$184/household)

The nation's first comprehensive program to evaluate the impact of providing evidence-based, non-medical interventions to high-needs Medicaid enrollees.



HC is a human services organization addressing the social determinants of health. The HOP program is an effective tool in ensuring better health, well being & longevity.

383 Medicaid households with chronic health conditions & occasional financial burdens were supported at an average of **\$925**/family
